Guardian Program



The care of the Confederate Soldier’s final resting place, His Grave, for as long as the member is physically able to do so; and to insure that the grave is marked so people know here rests a Confederate Soldier. That is the Guardian Program. There are Southern soldiers lying in unmarked and unattended graves throughout the world, in cemeteries that have been long forgotten. It is the accepted duty of the Sons to search out these cemeteries and graves and give them the care that they deserve.

Talk first started in January of 1992 in South Carolina when a few members of the division were returning from the funeral of Real Son Motte Junius Yarbrough. They stopped by an old cemetery. EM Clark, Jr. and I started talking with then SC Division Commander Robert L. Brown (1990-1994) about all the hard work being done by SCV members in these old cemeteries caring for Confederate graves. We all agreed that there should be some way to recognize these men for their work and the idea of starting a division program was suggested.

Commander Brown agreed with the idea of starting a state program to recognize members that took on the care of a Confederate Soldier’s grave for life. The main responsibilities are to ensure that the grave was marked as a Confederate Soldier in some way and that the grave was cared for. EM Clark, Terry Grissop and I started laying out the program and would meet with Commander Brown to go over the rules and guidelines. These four were the Guardian Committee and first four Guardians.

The SC Division Guardian Pin and Certificate were designed by Ernestine Amick Todd. The words on the pin “Final Bivouac” was taken from the entrance stone at the United Confederate Veterans (UCV) Camp Hampton section of Elmwood Cemetery in Columbia, SC.

The program became an official SC Division program March 27, 1993, at the SC Division reunion in Folly Beach, SC. It was here that the four of us sat down and voted E.M. Clark, Jr. the first member. Dennis Earl Todd was voted on second, Commander Robert L. Brown was third and William Terry Grissop was fourth. In 1994, at the Division Reunion in Columbia, SC, the first ten members were issued Guardian Pins and Certificates. They were EM Clark, Dennis Todd, Robert Brown, William Terry Grissop, Max Jackson, William DuBose, Charles Hanson, William “Bill” Bushall, and Randall Burbage.

Robert Brown remained on the committee until 1996 and then replaced by William DuBose. Brown was made an honorary member of the committee as he was one of the four founders.

In March 1999, the application and rules were updated. The main new item was a “Wilderness Grave Site”, graves completely neglected and abandoned in a wooded area. The very first Wilderness site approved by the committee was the grave of Private Hilliard Todd, in the Pond Field Graveyard in Horry County, SC.

The first Guardian chairman was E. M. Clark, Jr. serving until 2007. Then Steve Douglas was appointed chairman. The committee was taken from a four man committee to a chairman and one committee member from each of the ten SC Brigades. Also in 2012, Douglas had to reorder the Guardian Pins. While the design

remained the same Douglas was able to give the pin a more updated and modern look, as originally envisioned by the committee, but were unable for financial reasons.

By mid 2012, the SC program has had 400 plus guardians, with 285 still active and another 68 Guardian's Pro-Tem, caring for 958 plus Confederate graves.

As the SC Program continues to grow, other divisions have started Guardian Programs. Alabama being the first to start a program outside of SC. In August of 2008, Alabama with Compatriot Jimmy Hill being the chairman and their first guardian member, started its program. Then the Louisiana Division had the next program with Compatriot Milton Todd Owens as its chairman. Both of these programs are based on the one in South Carolina.

In July 2010, Commander-in-Chief Michael Givens (of South Carolina) asked me to start a national program and I immediately asked these men (Clark, Hill, and Owens) to help head the new National Guardian Program (NGP). It too was based on the South Carolina Program. The NGP was approved by the SCV General Executive Counsel (GEC) on March 19, 2011, and the first two applications were then approved (they are out of the Arkansas Division). There are now Guardians in the Divisions of South Carolina, Alabama, Louisiana, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, North Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, and West Virginia.

The national program was established for members of camps that do not come under a division command (such as H/Q camp) AND those divisions without a Guardian Program. If there is a Guardian Program within a division, the members of that division have to apply to that division and NOT to the national program.

Then, in March of 2012, Compatriot Phil Davis of the Texas Division notified me that he was the Chairman of the newly formed Texas Guardian Program.
